

Highlands County 4-H Official Award Application

Foundation Camp Scholarship Application

4-H camping is a large and important part of every youth's experience in the organization, however they often come with registration fees, or require extra money to be spent on food or other activities. This scholarship is to help lighten that load, and keep Highlands County 4-H involved in camping events.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. You must be a bonafide Highlands County 4-H member to receive this scholarship.
- 2. Funds must be used to attend a 4-H camp.
- 3. One member may apply for multiple camps, but each camp should have its own application, and not all may be approved.
- 4. The committee reserves the right to award partial scholarships.
- 5. You must turn in a record book to be eligible.

If you are selected to receive a Camp Scholarship, you must give a presentation to a group (the Foundation, leaders, a 4-H club, or an outside group of at least 10 non-family members) about your trip. Depending on the group you present to, presentation prompts may vary. Be sure to get a picture of yourself presenting, and ask to have a copy of the signin sheet to prove adequate attendance.

- ➤ Foundation/Leaders: Focus on what you got out of the trip. These people will be interested in what you learned, the fun you had, and what part of the trip was coolest to you.
- ➤ A 4-H Club: Market the camp to your peers. Leave the members of your audience wishing they had been there with you, and wanting to go next year.
- An outside group: Market 4-H to this group. They can be members, volunteers, or get the youth in their family involved. Show them why 4-H is so great, and how they can be a part of it.

Components of the Application

Be sure to include:

- 1. The 4-H Camp Scholarship Application Cover Page and Signature Page
- 2. A Building My Portfolio or Senior Portfolio
- 3. A Two-Page Essay, Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1.5 spaced.
 - a. Biography—tell your reader about yourself. What are the things that make you who you are?
 - b. Your 4-H Story—why is 4-H important to you? What kind of projects did you do this year? Did you attend other events? Highlight some of your favorite 4-H memories.
 - c. This Camp—how will this camp really benefit you/add to your story?
 - d. Conclusion—what is special about all the things you will take from your 4-H experience, specifically this camp?
