



Plant a potato in a large bucket and you should get a bucketful in about 4 months. Early spring or fall is the best time to plant.



- A POTATO
- SOIL
- COMPOST

Choose a potato with lots of eves. These aire buds that will begin to sprout if the potato is left in a light. airy place.







Keep covering the plant until the bucket is full. Keep the soil damp.




in 3 or 4 weeks when areen Shoots appear above the ground, add just enough soil to cover them again. This makes the stem push upward while little potatoes form below the ground.

when the plant flowers, it's a sign that things are happening underground. when the flowers die, Stop watering. Potatoes will have formed and wetness might make them

rot. When the whole plant dies, tip the Soll out and see how many potatoes you grew!






Small plants and straw flowers




Wash and dry the jar (remove label). Add pebbles and sand in a 1 inch layer. Add a layer of dirt 1"-z" deep. Transplant the plants into jar. Stick in some strawflowers. Sprinkle lightly with water. Place rocks around the plants and put lidon.

when the straw flowers get dry and open up, its time to water.







Toudb:

- 1. Lay a sheet of waxed paper (about 12"x12") on a flat surface
- 2. Place 100 small seeds or 50 large seeds in rows on the waxed paper.
- 3. Place two paper towels over the waxed paper and the seeds.
- 4. With your fingers, sprinkle water over the two paper towels until they are wet.
- 5. Roll the waxed paper and paper towels and tie with string as shown.
- 6. Without bending the roll, place it in the quart jar and set it in awarm place.



- 7. Check the roll daily. If it becomes dry, sprinkle it with water.
- 8. In 5 days take
 the roll from the
 jar. Until the
 string. Unroll and

 the towels from the
 waxed paper.





