Lafayette Homeschool Club Grows Plants and Size

The Lafayette County Homeschool 4-H Club continued it's learning about selfwatering container gardening in March. The homeschool students had planted tomato plants in earth boxes at their February meeting. The 4-Hers were surprised at the growth the tomato plants had made with minimal care or attention. This month, the youth made self-watering pots from two-liter soda bottles. These were made by cutting off the upper portion of the bottle and turning it upside down into the bottom portion of the bottle. You can see that March rainfall has us going into April with a good amount of saturation in our soils. We experienced a few rain events that allowed for several inches above the average rainfall for March.

The cold snap that we had seemed to cause a 25% loss of the watermelon crop which could have a big impact on the watermelon market this year. It seemed to also have a slight impact on corn that was already in the ground but since corn is a resilient plant, it will continue to thrive.

This is the ideal time for planning bulbs like blood lily, caladium, or canna as well as heat-loving herbs like basil, oregano, sage, and rosemary. You can also continue to plant your warm season vegetable crops. Also, mid-month is an ideal time to fertilize your lawn to encourage optimum growth.
