

## **MICROPLASTICS**

are found in waters around the world (see tiny.cc/microplastics). To test local waters, UF/IFAS **Extension Sarasota County** enrolled students and teachers from Sarasota and Riverview high schools into the Florida **Microplastics Awareness** Project, a citizen science initiative. Samples collected across the county and analyzed by students revealed:

- Fibers: from clothing, fleece, sheets and more;
- Fragments: from larger plastics, deodorants, mascaras, and others;
- Microbeads: spherical pieces of plastic added to scrubs, soaps, toothpastes and more; and
- Films: used to package food and protect crops.















## PERCENT OF SAMPLES **CONTAINING PLASTIC**
